### **Spending PSP Funds now - August 31, 2022**

- *Regular PSP guidelines continue to be in effect. This means that scholars and mentors should continue to do new activities on a monthly basis.*
- *PSP funds can be used on these senior year items:*

**Spending PSP Funds as a First Year College Student: September 1, 2022 – May 30, 2023**

- ALL scholars who have turned in their senior materials will have \$500 available to use for college books & supplies needed for schoolwork. See the list below. Scholars can also use these funds for virtual or in-person get together with your mentor.
- Scholars can earn an additional PSP scholarship of \$1,500 for college expenses and enrichment activities (for a total of \$2000). To qualify, scholars must:
  - Turn in senior materials by May 9
  - Attend at least 2 the PSP group events from this year (Japanese American Museum in Nov, Tree People in Feb, Whale Watching in May, Graduation in June)
  - Participate in at least 4 mentor/scholar activities during senior year (Sep '21 – August '22)
