PSP College Scholarship Program

During the COVID pandemic, PSP created a new scholarship program to support scholars through your first year of college. Over the years, we've expanded and made changes to fit the needs of college students.

Here's how it works...



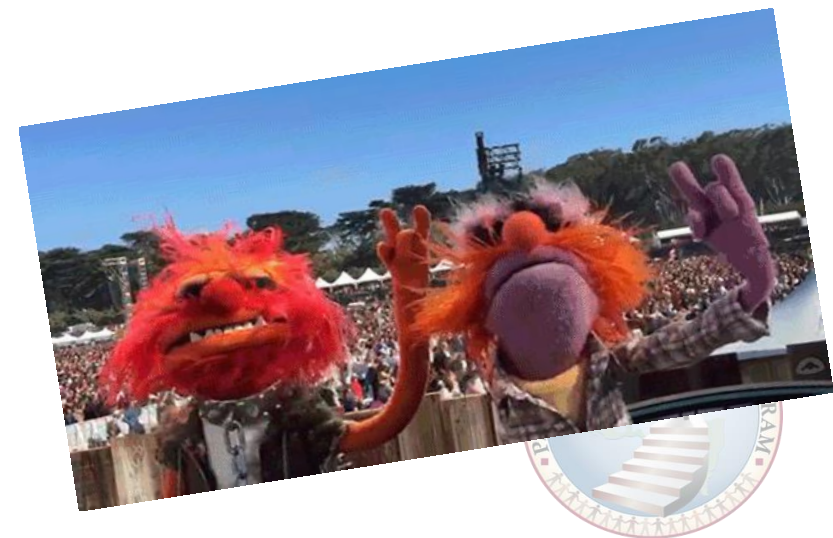
College Scholarship Eligibility

Regular PSP guidelines were in effect throughout senior year and the summer following graduation. PSP expected scholars to stay active in PSP during this final year of your high school career!

Seniors who remained active will receive a PSP scholarship to support you during your first year of college!

Being active in your senior year means:

- Participate in at least 10 activities during the school year & summer (Sep 1 – August 31).
- Turn in semester grades by the requested deadline
- Turn in Reflection Journals by the requested deadline.
- Turn in college materials by the deadline of May 12.



College Scholarship Amount

All scholars from the Class of 2023 will get a **\$1,500 scholarship** to spend in your first year of college!

*Your scholarship needs to be spent between
September 1, 2023 and June 31, 2024*



Using Your PSP College Scholarships

How to use your college scholarship:

Academic Expenses	Food & Recreational Expenses

The Logistics of How to Spend Your Scholarship

➤ PSP will pay for supplies & school fees directly – no need to go through a mentor or wait for a reimbursement for yourself or your parent.

- Mentors can spend funds for outings or virtual activities with you.
- If you use funds for a recreational activity, you still need to sign a waiver. Your parent doesn't if you're over 18.
- Save your receipt and send to Maria for reimbursement.
